# Guarantee Safe, Supportive Homes & Communities

Every young person deserves a stable home and community environment enriched with support and meaningful exposure to opportunities.

### **Serve with Love and Persistence**

Deliver services to youth with patience, consistency, and care—treating every interaction as a chance to heal. Adopt love as a framework in which policy is rooted.

#### Hire and Invest in Youth

Bring young people fully into the work that affects their lives. Hire them. Train them. Pay them. Financial stability is a foundation of safety and empowerment.



# Tell Stories. Humanize Data. Center Equity

Use storytelling to elevate lived experience. Behind every number is a person—this value should guide how we communicate and make decisions based on statistics. Center equity at every stage: from how metrics are defined to how results are shared. Always ask—who is being represented, who is being left out, and who gets to decide what matters?

#### Make Data Participatory

Youth, families, and communities need access, answers, and agency--not permission. Do research with youth, not on them. Engage them in asking questions, making meaning, and shaping how data is used.



#### **Prioritize Prevention and Invest in Stability**

Prevention must be the priority. When contact with the system occurs, youth need stability—achieved through cross-system collaboration and the dismantling of silos.

#### Address Overlooked Issues

Focus attention and resources on underrepresented issues like labor trafficking and the unique experiences of girls and gender-expansive youth.

# **Leverage the Transformative Power of Education Equitably**

Education should be an empowering, transformative experience for all young people.

#### **Share Power and Deepen Collaboration**

Strengthen partnerships between youth and others by sharing power, building trust, and co-creating solutions by those closest to the challenges and those closest to the opportunities to advance action.
