DCJS Youth Justice Indicator Dashboards: A Quick Reference Guide

What are the Youth Justice Indicator Dashboards?

The OJRP Youth Justice Research team launched three Youth Justice Indicator dashboards on the DCJS public website. These dashboards provide data visualizations at three processing points in the Youth Justice system including **Juvenile Delinquent Probation Intakes**, **Family Court Juvenile Delinquency Petitions**, and **Youth Probation Supervision**.

Where do I find the Youth Justice Indicator Dashboards?

The Youth Justice Indicator Dashboards can be found on the Youth Probation and Family Court Processing tab in the Youth Justice System section of the Statistics page on the DCJS Public website: https://www.criminaljustice.ny.gov/crimnet/ojsa/stats.htm

What do the dashboards include?

The Youth Justice Indicator dashboards each follow a similar structure to present and share the data in a standardized format:

- Landing Page A brief introduction and navigation guide for the dashboard data displays.
- **Data Notes** A glossary of key terminology and important notes about the data displayed on the dashboard.
- Opened Table An interactive table of cases opened by offense class, race/ethnicity, and age category.
- Closed Table An interactive table of cases closed by offense class, race/ethnicity, and outcome category.
- Annual Profile Visualizations that provide an overview of annual case-level data for a
 given year.
- Five-Year Trends Visualizations that provide a five-year lookback at relevant youth justice indicators.

How do I interact with the dashboards?

Filters – drop-down menus users can select to filter the information presented on the visualizations. Depending on which display a user looks at, they can filter the data visualizations by:

- Year The year in which the case was opened or closed
- NYS Region New York City or Non-New York City
- NYS County The county in which the case was opened or closed
- Race/Ethnicity The race or ethnicity category of the youth (Black, White, Hispanic, Other, Not Reported)
- **Sex** The sex of the youth (Male, Female, Other, Not Reported)
- **Age Category** The age category of the youth at the time of the offense (7-11, 12-15, 16-17, Not Reported)

Reset Filters - an action button that returns the data display to its default presentation showing all cases statewide. Note that this button does not reset the Year filter; users must manually change this filter if they want to see the information for a different year on the data display.

Tooltips – provide additional information when a user hovers their mouse over different parts of the data visualizations:

- **Label Tooltips** show all the descriptive labels for a table cell, a bar, or a line when a user hovers over parts of a visualization.
- **Number Tooltips** show additional numerical information (percentages or counts) not displayed on the main visualization.
- **Guidance Tooltips** include optimal download options, information on resetting filters, and support for navigating to different pages or data displays.

How do I download data displays from the dashboards?

To download the Opened Table and Closed Table in Excel:

- 1. Click the "Download Data" button on the upper right-hand side of the data display.
- 2. In the "Download Crosstab" pop-up window, ensure the name of the table is selected, not the "Reset" option.
- 3. Ensure "Excel" is selected under "Select Format" on the pop-up window.
- 4. Click "Download."
- 5. The Excel will appear in the Downloads section of the browser, File Explorer, or computer files. Click the file to open the Excel.

To download the Annual Profile and Five-Year Trends in PDF:

- 1. Click the "Download PDF" button on the upper right-hand side of the data display.
- 2. In the "Download PDF" pop-up window, select "Landscape" in the "Orientation" drop-down menu for the optimal view.
- 3. Click "Download."
- 4. The PDF will show up in the Downloads section of your browser, File Explorer, or computer files. Click the file to open the PDF.

Where do I find more information about the Youth Justice Indicator Dashboards?

The Data Notes section of each dashboard contains a glossary of key terminology and detailed information about the data presented on each dashboard. Users can navigate to them through the "Data Notes" button on the Landing Page, or the "Data Notes" tab at the top of the dashboard.

To ask questions about the data displayed on the dashboards, users can click the email button on the bottom right-hand corner of the Landing Page, which will prompt an email to dcjsJuvenileJustice@dcjs.ny.gov.











Juvenile Delinquent Probation Intakes Closed by Race/Ethnicity



* Racial and Ethnic Disparities in the Youth Justice System

This dashboard contains data on juvenile delinquency (JD) cases in New York State by race and ethnicity and county. The number and racial/ethnic breakdown of cases are shown for the following case processing points in the juvenile justice system: probation intakes opened, probation intakes referred to the presentment agency, probation intakes adjusted, petitions filed in Family Court, petitions resulting in a JD finding, petitions resulting in no JD finding, and probation supervision cases opened. The JD classification in the youth justice system refers to the following types of cases:

- Youth 12- to 15-years-old charged with a misdemeanor or felony offense;
- Youth 16- to 17-years-old charged with a misdemeanor; or
- Youth 16- to 17-years-old charged with a felony ("Adolescent Offender") whose cases are removed from the Youth Part of Criminal Court to Probation or Family Court.


Data represent the count and percent of cases by race/ethnicity at each case processing point in the juvenile justice system. Data represent cases at each point, not unique individuals. Data do not follow individual youth through the juvenile justice system.

For race/ethnicity, five categories are displayed: White, Black, Hispanic, Other Race/Ethnicity, and Not Reported. All cases involving youth of Hispanic ethnicity are reported in the Hispanic category, regardless of race. The Other Race/Ethnicity category includes cases of youth who are Asian/Pacific Islander, American Indian/Alaskan Native, or Other Race. Not Reported reflects cases that are missing data on race/ethnicity.


Population data for 2019-2020 are sourced from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, Division of Vital Statistics, National Center for Health Statistics. Population data for 2021-2024 are sourced from the U.S. Census Bureau; population data for 2024 utilizes 2023 population statistics. Data on Intakes Referred to Petition include cases that were referred to petition immediately and cases that received adjustment services but were ultimately referred to petition without successful adjustment.




Racial/Ethnic Breakdown by Juvenile Delinquency Process Point
